Berry Springs Rec Reserve

Fresh Facilities for Our Community!

A big shout-out to the NT Government's Community Benefit Fund and with operational assistance from Litchfield Council — we now have a brand-new half-basketball court and three fabulous shade structures.

The final landscaping stage is underway, we thank you for your patience. The finish line is in sight, and soon the Reserve will be back looking better than ever!



What's been happening at the Reserve?

It has been a busy few months for the Reserve Committee, and we are pleased to share some updates on the improvements and initiatives underway:

a. New Topsoil and Turf

New topsoil and turf has been installed around the recently upgraded areas, as well as in several older low-lying sections that required attention. These areas will remain off-limits while the turf establishes over the coming weeks. With water meter assessments now completed by Litchfield Council and recent irrigation repairs carried out, we are confident the grounds will soon return to a healthy, lush green.

b. Landscape Master Plan

The Committee is working with Landscape Architect, Fiona Eddleston, who is drafting a Landscape Master Plan for the Berry Springs Recreation Reserve. While the plan is still in its early stages and will involve consultation with the community and stakeholders, we are excited to be planning for the future of the Reserve and to see the space continue to evolve.



c. Plumbing Maintenance

Over the past few months, the Committee has been able to undertake significant plumbing maintenance that had been pending. There are, however, still a number of projects to be completed — including works around the meeting room and outside the kitchen. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and will do our best to minimise disruption.

d. Congratulations – Berry Springs Markets

Congratulations to the Berry Springs Market Association NT, who held their first successful market in June. The following events have demonstrated the capability, dedication, and community spirit of the new association. We are excited by their success and positivity and look forward to seeing their continued growth and contribution to the Berry Springs community in the future.



e. Security Audit

A full security audit of the Reserve has been completed. As part of this process, locks have been updated and additional measures introduced to improve safety and security. Please note that vehicle access to the rear of the Reserve (via the chain fence) will no longer be permitted. This change has been made to ensure the health and safety of all who use the area.

f. Funding Agreement with Litchfield Council

We are pleased to announce that the 2025/2026 Funding Agreement between Litchfield Council and Berry Springs Recreation Reserve Inc. has now been signed. Under this agreement, Litchfield Council will continue to support the Reserve by contributing to repairs and maintenance, as well as the ongoing operational costs of its asset. This supports the Management Committee's focus on maintaining, improving, and activating the Reserve for the benefit of the community. The funding provides greater certainty for the year ahead and allows the Committee to plan with confidence — ensuring the Reserve remains a safe, well-cared-for, and welcoming space for all who use it.

g. New Cleaner Appointed

We are welcoming a new cleaner at the Reserve, who will help ensure facilities are kept to a high standard, with greater attention to detail and presentation for all who use the space.


